SELECTMEN'S MEETING
MINUTES
06/30/2008

The meeting was opened at 7:00 pm.

MINUTES: The minutes of 06-23-08 were approved.

SELECTMEN'S ISSUES:

CU Application - Russ Rigoli met with the board to discuss his current use application. The board explained to Mr. Rigoli that the land that the wells and fireworks trailer are on cannot be in current use. Mr. Rigoli told the board that he will eventually be removing the fireworks trailer and that he feels there should be some exception for the land the wells are on. Mr. Rigoli needs to amend the application, deducting the land the wells and trailer are on. He will bring the measurements into the office on Wednesday. The board will review the application again.

Rex Barkwell-Junkyard – Mr. Barkwell came in to notify the board that he is in the process of cleaning up his property. He has notified the owners of the “junk” that it needs to be removed. He also expressed his concern over the high cost of property taxes.

TS Stickers – The board agreed that transfer station stickers must be affixed to vehicles. A sign will be put up at the Transfer Station notifying residents of this.

Speed Limits-Gravel Roads – Mark Andrew spoke with Police Chief Bill Main about possibly lowering speed limits on gravel roads. The Chief suggested using more signage at dangerous spots, such as Cross Road and Groton Hollow Road where the guard rails were going to be placed.

ADMINISTRATION:

Paving Bid – R&D accepted the job as bid. The job will not exceed \$76,000. The extra \$1,000.00 will come from the highway budget if needed. The paving will be completed by mid-September.

NE Salem – The Director of NE Salem notified Anne Dow that the name is changing to Stinson Lake Trust, Inc. and will remain a non-profit corp. The PILT agreement will be changed to reflect the correct name.

Town Report Cover – Some residents have suggested using different pictures on the town report cover, other than town equipment. The board will ask for suggestions through the town web site, the Rumney Register and the town news column in the Record Citizen. Residents will be asked to send in photos through October 15th and then the board will pick a photo for the cover.
