  members to position their vehicles, when responding to these types of calls, at least one
  telephone pole back from the scene, for safety reasons. The Chief also asked that whenever
  possible to limit POV, he would prefer to have engines brought to scene, for safety of members,
  but also if engines are needed to block the roads.
- 2018 Buffalo Rd- Address has been flagged. Members are to stage at Sandhill and Buffalo Rds, and wait for Police if toned to this address.
- Truck Committee- the Chief is actively getting a truck committee formed. He is hoping to begin meeting soon. If any fire fighters were interested in being a part,let him know.
- The Chief commented on how well the plant sale was attended and thanked the Ladies Auxiliary.

- CPR- Beth will talk to Pemi Baker about possibly sending someone here to do a class for us.
- Chief Hacker informed the members that he is in the process of applying for a grant for a side by side w/a trailer, and trax. The side by side would be used for ice rescues, climbing/hiking rescues, ect.
- The Chief mentioned the RES school picnic on June 10, and was looking for members that might be available to go with a truck.

A motion was made to adjourn the meeting at 8:15, by Dan. The motion was seconded by Jody. All agreed.
