





PARADE REGISTRATION FORM

Parade starts at 10:00am. Arrive by 9:30am to check in. We will greet you at both locations. 2024 THEME: "Naturally Rumney" – We look forward to a fun day of themed or patriotic entries.

<u>Motorized Vehicles</u> (autos, antique cars, bands, buses, emergency vehicles, tractors, trucks). Follow Main Street to 252 Stinson Lake Road and proceed into the second entrance on the right into "White Mountain Fiberglass Boat Repair" to check in and line up as designated by parade organizers.

<u>Walkers</u> (including scooters, lawn chair brigade, bicycles, community or political organizations, floats, marchers, vehicles accompanied by walkers, pre-approved animal entries). Check in for the line-up, and at the Mill Road entrance, corner of Stinson Lake Road. For safety, floats and vehicles that are accompanied by walkers, are to follow the entire parade route and turn around before the traffic light intersection. The rest of the walkers end the parade participation at the end of the common. Walk to the side of Quincy Road and enter the common.

<u>Parade Route</u>: Follow the assigned starting points towards Main Street, **past the common, and over the green bridge, to reach the end point at the light** intersecting with Route 25. To return to the event, please turn around prior to the light intersection in the restaurant parking lot on the right side. The police will close off traffic on the side streets at the common during the parade, and also request that candy be handed to parade spectators, not tossed.
