Rachel opened the meeting with time to read over the previous meeting notes. Stephan motioned to accept the minutes with corrections, Lila seconded, and the vote carried.

 - o Entertainment - Beth will look into contacting the person who teaches line dancing at the Edge of Town Tavern. Heather will connect with Paul Ronci of Rusty Bones band.
- Cathy Hacker noted that the Leggs will have chalk available for children to use, and there will be rocks that children can paint - more details on rock painting coming.

Kathy G. & Lila have been selling raffle tickets at the transfer station.

An update on raffles was given by both Kathy G. & Beth M.

Lila gave a report on several items: A megaphone (value \$51.00) was donated. A 43" smart TV was donated as a raffle prize. Nick will have the dump truck available for trash until shortly before the transfer station closes. Lori Eaton has signed the parking agreement (Eaton's property) with the town. Lila has issued a refund for the crafter who is unable to attend and had already sent in payment. Recent checks have been issued to the bands, Hells Gate Fireworks, Lisa Russell, and petty cash for the event.

The Scroggins will be getting more plexiglass for the a-frame signs on the common at a cost of \$132.00. Stephan made the motion to approve the purchase; Cathy H. Seconded and the motion carried.
