Article 1: Negotiate and Execute Tuition Contracts

Article 2: School Board Contingency Fund

To see if the School District will vote to establish a contingency fund in accordance with Revised Statutes Annotated 198:4-b, such contingency fund to meet the cost of unanticipated expenses that may arise during the year and, further, to raise and appropriate the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) for such contingency fund. The School Board **recommends** this article. (Majority vote required.)

Article 3: Operating Budget

Shall the Pemi-Baker Regional School District vote to raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including appropriations by special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately, the amounts set forth on the budget posted with the warrant or as amended by vote of the first session for the purposes set forth therein, totaling Seventeen Million, Eight Hundred Eighty-Nine Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty-Six dollars (\$17,889,956)?

Should this article be defeated, the default budget shall be Seventeen Million Six Hundred Twenty-Eight Thousand Six Hundred Eighty-Six dollars (\$17,628,686), which is the same as last year, with certain adjustments required by previous action of the Pemi-Baker Regional School Board, or by law or the governing body may hold one special meeting, in accordance with RSA 40:13, X and XVI, to take up the issue of a revised operating budget only. This sum excludes the sum in Warrant Article 2. The School Board **recommends** this article. (Majority vote required.)
